Uber vehicle overturned by French taxi drivers (2015)



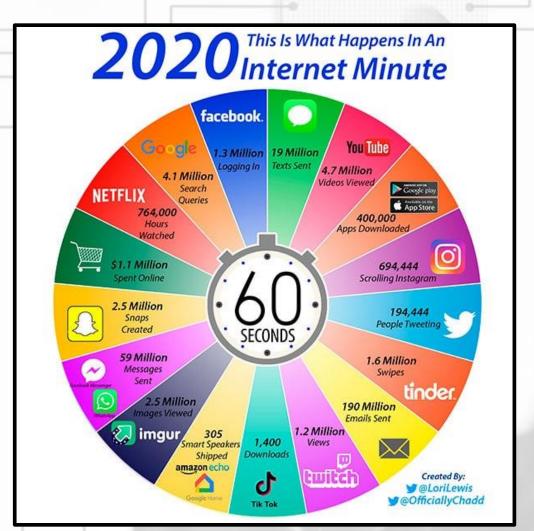
The corporate landscape is littered with co's that did not adapt quickly enough – Kodak, Polaroid, Blackberry, Blockbuster, Yahoo! .....
